- (4) Based on the admissibility, exclusion, eligibility, selection and award criteria laid down in the annual work programme and published in the calls for proposals, the submitted proposal has been selected to receive financial support under the EDF.

- (5) Based on the admissibility, exclusion, eligibility, selection and award criteria laid down in the annual work programme and published in the calls for proposals, 22 proposals have been selected to receive financial support under the EDF. Another 18 proposals have been placed on a reserve list.
- (6) This Decision concerns proposals which under Article 11(2) of Regulation (EU) 2021/697 require a Commission award decision in *mode décisionnel*.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The 22 proposals listed in Annex 2 are awarded a grant under the 2022 EDF calls for a total maximum grant amount of EUR 298,291,384.95. The 18 proposals listed in Annex 3 are placed on a reserve list.

The list of awarded proposals mentions the corresponding call and, where applicable, the topic, the consortium's coordinator and its country of establishment, the estimated total eligible costs of the action and the maximum amount awarded.

Article 2

Proposals listed in Annex 3 (reserve list) successfully complied with the exclusion, eligibility, selection and award criteria laid down in the calls text but are considered rejected for lack of budgetary appropriations.

Proposals in the reserve list may be selected for grants in case budgetary appropriations are available.

Moreover, where the proposals selected for funding failed the grant preparation, proposals from the reserve list under the same call might be selected for funding, in the strict order of their ranking.
