The project "Artificial Intelligence for Defence" (AI4DEF) will demonstrate the benefits of AI on military functional areas, such as situation awareness, decision-making and planning optimization. To illustrate the transversal and scalable approach of AI4DEF as a cloud service platform, it will be implemented in multiple domains such as UAV (unmanned aerial vehicle) missions with means-of-effect optimisation, enhanced Joint ISR (intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance) analysis, tactical situation awareness and decision-making.
